The Management, Professional Staff and the Holiday Club invite you to participate in the New Jersey Open Invitational. The dates for this year's event are **May 8-9, 2010**. The invitational will include all USARS Level A, B, and C Events, and Eastern Region Intro Events. The open invitational will use the second and third requirements as listed in the May 1, 2010 regional draw. With the current state of the economy we are going to do our best to run this meet in two days to help keep everyone's travel expenses to a minimum. We were able to do this last year and we expect to be able to do this again. In the slight chance that our entries are much larger than the last year we will schedule the Level B, C and Intro events as late as we can on Friday, May 7, 2010. If we do this (chances are very small) Level B, C, and Intro events will have the option of a full refund of their entry fees if they chose not to participate.

All USA Roller Skating rules will be followed as outlined for the 2010 National Roller Skating Championships. Entry fees are \$28.00 for the first event and \$23.00 for each additional event.
Entry deadline is April 16, 2010. Spectators will be admitted free.

FACILITY

The skating center is 210' x 90' plastic coated maple. The sound system will accommodate official cassette tapes and CDs.

AWARDS

Custom awards will be presented to all 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place winners. All contestants registered in the Intro Events will receive an award.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. All skaters must hold a current 2010 USA Roller Skating amateur card or purchase a single event card for \$20.00 at registration. Note: If you were a full USA Roller Sports member last season you may not use a single event card this season.
2. Skaters may enter only those official events in which they are eligible to compete at the 2010 Regional Championship. Primary A, Juvenile A, Elementary A, Freshman A and Sophomore A **MAY NOT** challenge up within these divisions. Elementary A, Freshman A and Sophomore A skaters may challenge up to Junior, Jr. World Class or World Class (1 additional event). Level C skaters may challenge up to Levels B. Level B skaters may challenge up to Level A. Crossovers **WILL NOT** be allowed between the Novice, Esquire, Masters, Veterans but they may challenge up to Premier Silver or Gold (either but not both). Intro skaters may only challenge up to the lowest Level B or C event for their age group.
3. All events will be run using the official national rules.

INTRO EVENTS

- An open event for skaters who have never competed in a National Championship in that artistic event.
- Skaters who exceed the skill level of Intro will be asked to register in Level C, B or A Standard divisions in future competitions.
- Four placements will be awarded and all entries in Tot and Primary Intro Events will receive a participation award.
- All Intro events will be skated as a final event only.
- There will be six age groups as follows: (Age as of 1/1/2009)
 - Tot Intro – 6 years old and under (No Team Dance)
 - Primary Intro – 7 to 8 years old (No Team Dance)
 - Juvenile Intro - 9 to 10 years old (No Team Dance)
 - Elementary Intro - 11 to 12 years old (Team Dance for all skaters 12 & Under)
 - Fresh/Soph Intro - 13 to 18 years old
 - Adult Intro - 19 years old and older

Intro Free Skating Rules:

Time: 2:00 Minutes Maximum, after which the music will be faded.

Music: Any music may be used, including vocal, as long as content is deemed appropriate.

Content: Maximum of (5) half turn or full turn jumps. Maximum of (3) upright spins. Creative footwork, splits, spread eagles and shoot-the-ducks are encouraged.

Content Restrictions: One and half revolution jumps and sit spins are beyond the skill level of the Intro divisions and will not be scored if attempted.

NJ State Meet Annual Challenge Plaques: The State challenge plaques will be presented to the winner of all divisions for which a plaque exists. Plaques presented to Eastern Region skaters will require an acceptance signature of a member of the Eastern Region Artistic Coaches Association in order for the skater to take the plaque with them. Out of region skaters will have their name engraved on the plaques; however the NJ State Committee will retain possession of such plaques.

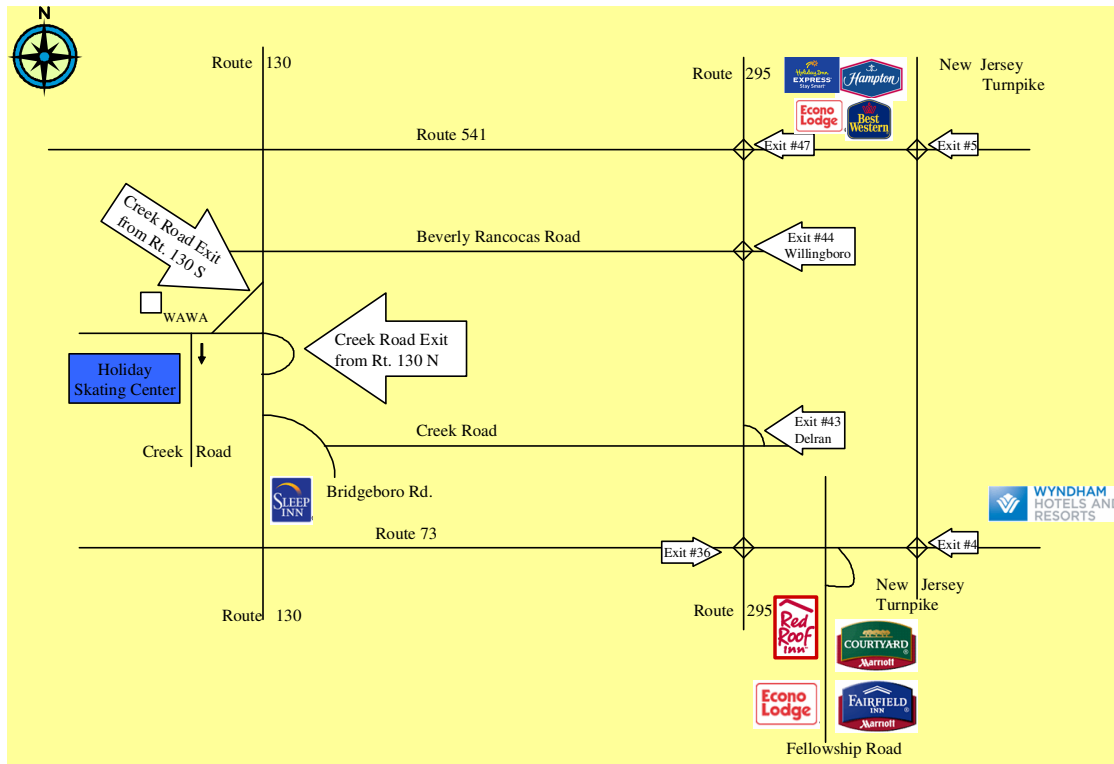

MAP AND DIRECTIONS



FROM THE:

- North - NJ Turnpike South to Exit 6 (PA Turnpike Extension Exit), Exit off of the extension before getting into PA on the Rt. 130 South Exit. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
- West - PA Turnpike across bridge into New Jersey. Get off at the first exit after the bridge onto Rt. 130 South. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
- South- NJ Turnpike North to Exit 4, Rt. 73 North to Rt. 130 North, Rt. 130 North to Delanco (about 4 or 5 miles) to Creek Road Jug Handle Exit. Follow Creek Rd. after exiting Rt. 130 - Turn left at first street (about 300 yards) - The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
