The invitational will include all USARS Level A, B, and C Events, Eastern Region Intro Events and the Eastern Region Youth Development Program. The open invitational will use the second and third requirements as listed in the May 1, 2015 regional draw. For events that only have two requirements we will be using the 1st and 2nd requirements.

All USA Roller Skating rules will be followed as outlined for the 2015 National Roller Skating Championships.

Entry fees are \$30.00 for the first event and \$20.00 for each additional event. Eastern Region Youth Development Program Registration is \$20.00 per event registered.

A \$10.00 fee will be charged additionally for combined events.

Entry deadline is April 16, 2015. Spectators will be admitted free.

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FACILITY

The skating center is 210' x 90' plastic coated maple. The sound system will accommodate official CDs only.

AWARDS

Custom awards will be presented to all 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners. All contestants registered in the Intro Events will receive an award. All contestants registered in the Eastern Region Youth Development Program will receive certificate awards.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1) All skaters must hold a current 2015 USA Roller Skating membership card if they are registering in official USARS events. (Level C, Level B and Level A events) Skaters registering in just the Eastern Region Youth Development Program Events and Intro Events may skate without a membership card if the attached USARS Liability Waiver is completed and returned with the registration form.
- 2) Skaters may enter only those official events in which they are eligible to compete at the 2015 Regional Championship. Primary, Juvenile A, Elementary A, Freshman A and Sophomore A may challenge up one event within these divisions. Elementary A, Freshman A and Sophomore A skaters may also challenge up to Junior, Jr. World Class or World Class (as eligible by age). Level C skaters may challenge up to Level B. Level B skaters may challenge up to Level A. Crossovers will be allowed between the Novice, Esquire, Masters, Veterans and Golden and they may challenge up to Premier Silver or Gold (either but not both). Golden Team Dance skaters may also register in Veterans Team Dance since Golden Team Dance is an unofficial event. Intro skaters may only challenge up to the lowest Level B or C event for their age group. Intro Skaters age 8 and under may challenge up to Primary and/or Juvenile C.
- 3) All events will be run using the official national rules.

INTRO EVENTS

- An open event for skaters who **have never competed** in a Regional Championship in an Official artistic event. (Level C, Level B and Level A events)
- Skaters who exceed the skill level of Intro will be asked to register in Level C, B or A Standard divisions in future competitions.
- Three placements will be awarded and all entries in Intro Events will receive a participation award.
- All Intro events will be skated as a final event only.
- There will be six age groups as follows: (Age as of 1/1/2015)
 - Tot Intro – 6 years old and under (No Team Dance)
 - Primary Intro – 7 to 8 years old (No Team Dance)
 - Juvenile Intro - 9 to 10 years old (No Team Dance)
 - Elementary Intro - 11 to 12 years old (Team Dance for all skaters 12 & Under)
 - Fresh/Soph Intro - 13 to 18 years old
 - Adult Intro - 19 years old and older

Intro Free Skating Rules:

Time: Maximum of two minutes (+/- 5 seconds)

Music: Any music may be used, including vocal, as long as content is deemed appropriate.

Content: Maximum of 5 jumps. Half or single jumps only. May only include one combination jump, which will count as one jump. Maximum of 3 upright spins. May only include one combination spin, which will count as one spin. **No camel or sit spins.**

Eastern Region Youth Development Program Events: These events are for skaters who represent clubs in the Eastern Region only. **Skaters from outside the Eastern Region may not enter these events.** Please go to the www.erusars.org web page and go to the contest page to see our current rules. You can also download the current singles music there.

NJ State Meet Annual Challenge Plaques: The State challenge plaques will be presented to the winner of all divisions for which a plaque exists. Plaques presented to Eastern Region skaters will require an acceptance signature of a member of the Eastern Region Artistic Coaches Association in order for the skater to take the plaque with them. Out of region skaters will have their name engraved on the plaques; however the NJ State Committee will retain possession of such plaques. Please Note: Challenge Plaques **WILL NOT** be created for the new Eastern Region Youth Development Program Divisions.

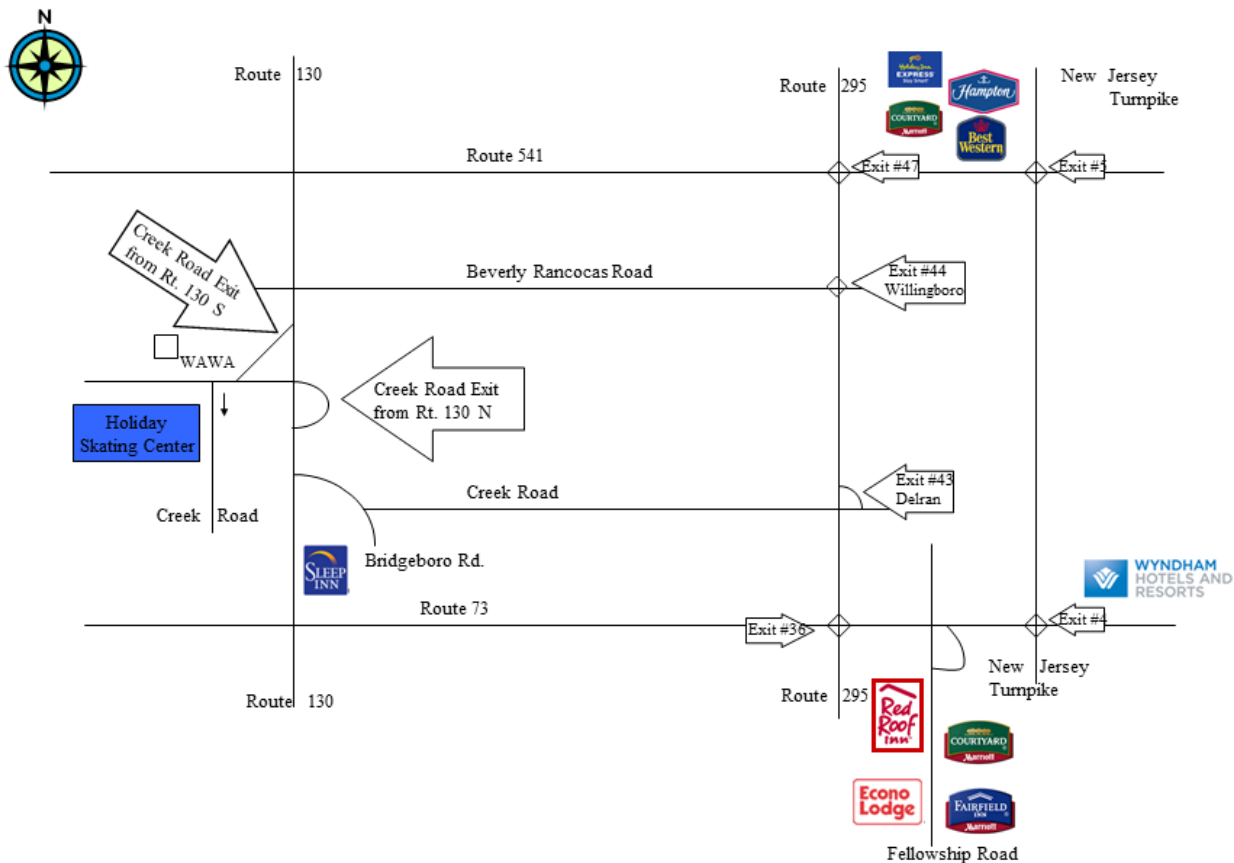

FROM THE:

- North - NJ Turnpike South to Exit 6 (PA Turnpike Extension Exit), Exit off of the extension before getting into PA on the Rt. 130 South Exit. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right 1/4 mile down the road.
- West - PA Turnpike across bridge into New Jersey. Get off at the first exit after the bridge onto Rt. 130 South. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right 1/4 mile down the road.
- South- NJ Turnpike North to Exit 4, Rt. 73 North to Rt. 130 North, Rt. 130 North to Delanco (about 4 or 5 miles) to Creek Road Jug Handle Exit. Follow Creek Rd. after exiting Rt. 130 - Turn left at first street (about 300 yards) - The skating center is on the right 1/4 mile down the road.

I, _____, the undersigned, do hereby affirm and acknowledge that I have been informed of the inherent hazards and risks associated with the sport of roller skating, transportation of equipment related to the activities, and traveling to and from activity sites in which I am about to engage. I further agree to abide by the rules and regulations of USARS during the terms of this registration and agree to observe the Amateur Code of Conduct, in spirit as well as in letter, upholding the high ethics of amateur roller skating. I agree that I will wear the protective gear that is required by USARS.

I understand that dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the action or inaction of others participating in these activities. I understand the nature of USARS' activities and believe that I (or my minor child) am/are qualified and physically fit to participate in roller skating competitions and practices. I further acknowledge that I am aware that activity will be conducted in facilities that may be open to the public. As a skater, parent or legal guardian, I further agree and warrant that prior to participating in any event I will inspect the facilities to be used and if believing conditions are unsafe, I will immediately advise my coach or the host of this condition and refuse to participate unless corrected.

I fully understand that USARS' activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, and economic losses which might result not only from a skater's action, inaction or negligence, but the action, inaction or negligence of others, the rules of competition, or the condition of the premises or any equipment in use. I fully accept and assume all such risks and responsibilities for losses and costs and damages incurred as a result of my participation in USARS activities or arising out of my traveling to or returning from such activities or practice sessions.

I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue and agree to hold harmless with respect to any and all injury, disability, death or loss of damage to persons or property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or part by their negligence, the following persons or entities:
